

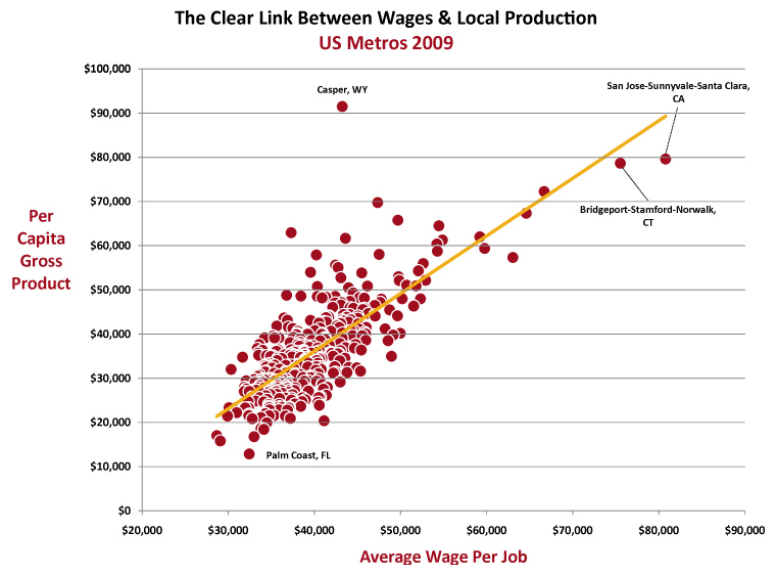
# The Clear Link between Wages & Local Production

## *How Did Your Community Rank?*

Lost among many programs and plans to increase local wages is the undeniably clear link between wages and local production. In simple terms, **the higher the value of products and services your community produces, the higher your wages** (see chart).

The link highlights the importance of labor productivity and the mix of local industries. As of 2009, the highest average wage per job among 366 U.S. metro areas can be found in *San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara, CA*. The metro also has the nation's second highest per capita gross product at \$79,604, driven in large part from *Manufacturing (Computer and Electronic Products)* and *Professional and Business Services* activities. The *Brownsville-Harlingen, TX* metro has the lowest



average wage job at \$28,669, and unsurprisingly, the second lowest per capita gross product, \$17,024. By comparison, one-half of the *Brownsville-Harlingen, TX* metro's output comes from the *Retail Trade, Health/Social Services, and Government* industries, while these same industries comprise just 16 percent of the *San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara, CA* metro's output. An interesting outlier to the wage-production link is *Casper, WY*, which experienced a surge in the value of its per capita gross product due mainly to growth in local mining activity, but has yet to experience a corresponding increase in wages.

## Ranking the Top & Bottom by Per Capita Gross Product

In brief the top ten metros are populated by energy-resource rich or high knowledge production areas. While the bottom are ten represented by low-production, tourism or retirement driven economies.
